

Dr. Young Hai Park is an Emeritus Professor of Humanities at Sookmyung Women's University , where she served as Dean of the College of Liberal Arts(1996-2000); Director of the Research Center for Asian Women(1979-81;1985-87); and Founding Director of the Francophones Studies Center,-

Dr. Park served also as the President of Korean Association of Women's Studies(1986-1987), the President of the *Societe Coreenne de Langue et Litterature Francaises* (SCLLF 2006-2007)), and the President of the *Association Coreenne d'Etudes sur la Culture et des Arts en France* (CFAF 2002-2004).

Dr. Park, eminent scholar and NGO leader at the same time, made a remarkable contribution to promote women's status on national, regional and international levels. through her important positions such as the Asia Pacific Regional Coordinator of BPW International(2008-2011), the Vice-President of International Council of Women(2003-2006), the Vice-President of the Korean National Council of Women(1994-2000), the President of BPW Korea(1993-1995). She organised or participated in many conferences and workshops on women's issues in preparation of UN Conferences on women since Copenhagen and attended CSW meetings regularly as part of APWW(Asia Pacific Women's Watch) or BPW delegates to work on BPFA or MDGs. In recent years, she has been working closely with APWINC and especially with AWEC as Organising Committee Advisor since last year.

Dr. Park, a graduate of Seoul National University(1965), received a Ph. D from the University of Paris-Sorbonne in Comparative Literature (1971), and carried out her research as Post-doctoral Scholar, at UCLA(1976-1977) and Visiting Scholar at Harvard (1989-1990).

Dr. Park has been awarded the Order of National Merit (Nokjokeunjung Hunjang), Republic of Korea, in 2008, and the Order of Commandeur des Palmes Academiques, France in 2009.
